## TODAY WE REMEMBER ANZAC DAY

**APRIL 25, 2021** 

Ottawa, Today – Mr. Stéphane Ouellette, President and Chief Executive Officer. Merchant Navy Commemorative Theme Project (MNCTP) and the Honourable Andrew Furey, Premier of Newfoundland and Labrador, observed ANZAC Day. This was to honour the men and women of the Australian and New Zealand Army Corps (ANZAC), and the Royal Newfoundland Regiment (then The Newfoundland Regiment), who fought in The Gallipoli Campaign during World War One.



It was on April 25, 1915, when Australian, New Zealand, and Newfounland soldiers landed on the Gallipoli peninsula in Turkey to open the Dardanelles Strait to the allied navies. Meeting fierce resistance from the Ottoman Turkish defenders, their mission was to capture Constantinople (now Istanbul), the capital of the Ottoman Empire (an ally of Germany). The Gallipoli campaign resulted in over 35,000 killed or wounded. In addition, the Turkish defenders suffered more than 250,000 casualties.

The Royal Newfoundland Regiment was the only North American regiment involved in the campaign. More than 1,000 Newfoundlanders served, with 115 wounded or dead.
